

**DECLARATION
RE: LOCAL IMPROVEMENT**

I, Mike Koziol, of The City of Edmonton, in the Province of Alberta, do solemnly declare that pursuant to Sections 226 & 396 of the *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26 (MGA):

1. The City of Edmonton has given proper notice of intention dated March 17, 2004, to undertake and complete the construction of the L.I. Plan 33 described in Bylaw 13694;

2. 30 days after the sending of the Notices have now elapsed, and:

✓ a) No sufficiently signed and valid petition against the said proposal has been received pursuant to sections 226 and 392 of the MGA (2/3 of the owners, representing at least 1/2 of the value of the assessments);

b) A sufficiently signed and valid petition against the said proposal has been received (a majority of owners, representing at least 1/2 of the value of the assessments).
