



Borden Park's natural swimming experience to be first of its kind in Canada

The City of Edmonton is in the final stages of developing plans for the Borden Natural Swimming Experience as part of the Borden Park Revitalization.

Residents are invited to hear more information and ask questions about this proposed environmentally, sustainable facility.

Borden Park Natural Swimming Experience will be the first public amenity of its kind in Canada and will provide unique, year-round recreational opportunities for Edmontonians while honouring the history of the park. The unique design of the basins will allow for the water to freeze for winter activities such as ice skating.

The facility will rely on natural biological filtration and will be a chemical-free, outdoor swimming facility during the summer.

The Borden Park Revitalization also includes construction of a new park pavilion, playground, fountain, gardens, refurbished historically designated bandshell, landscaping, walkways and park furniture.
