

Final advance vote turnout for the 2013 Edmonton Election

Ten days of advance voting in the 2013 Edmonton Election ended with 23,076 residents voting for the candidates of their choice. This is an increase of 15 percent from the 2010 election when 20,069 citizens cast ballots in advance voting.

On <u>Election Day,</u> Monday, October 21, 2013, voting stations will be open across the city from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. Where to vote notices were delivered to Edmonton homes letting occupants know about the voter eliqibility requirements, where to find their voting station and



what candidates are running in their ward. Voters can also use the where to vote tool online at edmonton.ca/election to locate their voting station.

The voter identification requirements have changed for the 2013 Edmonton Election. Voters must present one piece of authorized identification that establishes both their name and current residential address in order to . vote. An Alberta Driver's Licence, personal cheque or residential utility bill are included in the list of acceptable forms of ID. Voters in Ward Six should note that voting station 06-10, the Hellenic Canadian Community Hall, will be moved to Oliver Elementary School at 10227-118 Street.

Starting at approximately 8:30 p.m. on Election Night, unofficial election results will be available at edmonton.ca/electionresults. Results will be updated on an ongoing basis until all voting stations have reported their numbers. Barring unforeseen circumstances, all results should be in by 11 p.m.
