

Availability of Edmonton Elections Officials on Election Day

The City of Edmonton's Returning Officer, Alayne Sinclair, will be available to members of the media on Election Day to provide an update on voter turnout figures and information on any election-related issues.

Time: 11:30 a.m.

Location: Media Room, City Hall



A second voter turnout update will be issued by news release at 4:30 p.m. on Election Day.

Election Day Media Guidelines

- Media coverage must not interfere with the smooth operation of voting stations.
- Camera crews and still photographers may take general visuals of individuals entering voting stations and of the voting process from the voting station entrance only.
- No interviews or scrums are permitted inside voting stations.
- All media must respect the wishes of voters who do not want to be photographed.

Election Night Results

Starting at approximately 8:30 p.m. on Election Night, unofficial election results will be available at edmonton.ca/electionresults. Results will be updated on an ongoing basis until all voting stations have reported their numbers. Barring unforeseen circumstances, all results should be in by 11 p.m.
