- Media coverage must not interfere with the smooth operation of voting stations.
   Camera crews and still photographers may take general visuals of individuals entering voting stations and of the voting process from the voting station entrance only.
- No interviews or scrums are permitted inside voting stations.
  All media must respect the wishes of voters who do not want to be photographed.

Starting at approximately 8:30 p.m. on Election Night, unofficial election results will be available at edmonton.ca/electionresults. Results will be updated on an ongoing basis until all voting stations have reported their numbers. Barring unforeseen circumstances, all results should be in by 11 p.m.
