

Countdown to campaign clean-up

City reminds candidates to remove all signs by midnight Thursday, October 24, 2013

Candidates who ran in the municipal election have until midnight on Thursday, October 24, 2013 to take down signs or face big fines.

All election signs must be removed from public property within three days of the election. Starting Friday, October 25, 2013 the City of Edmonton's Community Standards Peace Officers will begin removing any remaining signs and may fine candidates up to \$250 per sign.



Candidates and residents with plastic or cardboard campaign signs are encouraged to recycle them at any of these locations:

- Edmonton Waste Management Centre (13111 Meridian Street)
 Ambleside Eco Station (14710 Ellerslie Road SW)
 Recycling Depots (signs must be disassembled and put in the co-mingled material bins)
