

## Tree of Memories Returns to Edmonton Cemeteries

Last year, thousands of beautiful lights shone from a [Tree of Memories](#) in the City of Edmonton's Beechmount Cemetery. This year, a Tree of Memories can be found in both Beechmount and Mount Pleasant cemeteries, bearing blue lights to symbolize the memories of loved ones who have passed on.

Guests are invited to participate in this tradition by bringing an ornament to Beechmount or Mount Pleasant and placing it on the tree. All are welcome during daylight hours between November 15 and December 25. Because Edmonton's winter conditions can be unpredictable, it's recommended that ornaments should not be too delicate or of great sentimental value.



Those who wish to retrieve their ornaments can do so before January 15, 2014.

Beechmount Cemetery's main gate is at 12420 – 104 Street. Mount Pleasant Cemetery is at 5420 – 106 Street.

Edmontonians are encouraged to visit the City's scenic and peaceful municipal cemeteries year-round.
