# ETS and partners launch 2013 ETS Stuff a Bus campaign

Edmonton Transit System (ETS) representatives and their campaign partners are launching the 2013 ETS Stuff a Bus campaign. They're calling on Edmontonians to help drive out hunger during the holiday season.

ETS volunteers will be collecting non-perishable food at various transit centres and Save-On-Foods stores in Edmonton. This year's goal is to fill 15 buses with food.

### Saturday, November 30, 2013

This is the major collection day for the campaign, when ETS volunteers and buses will be at all 13 Save-On-Foods stores in Edmonton from 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m.

"The annual ETS Stuff a Bus campaign has become a major food drive for our organization during the Festive Campaign," said Marjorie Bencz, CM, Executive Director of Edmonton's Food Bank. "We food raise and fundraise can by can and dollar by dollar. Donations not only help us during the festive season but into 2014 as well."

Since initiated in 1995, the City's Stuff a Bus campaign has collected over 326,000 kilograms of food and over \$340,000 in cash to help people in need.
