

Parking Ban Enforcement Update

Neighbourhood Blading Begins

Edmonton's first seasonal parking ban of the winter season resulted in 1272 tickets being issued by Bylaw Enforcement Officers, about 200 fewer than were issued during the last two-day parking ban in March.

"Considering the length of the parking ban, the number of violations was relatively low per day," said Erin Blaine, Parking Enforcement Coordinator, Bylaw Enforcement (Community Services). "We would prefer to see even higher compliance from some areas of the City, and we will focus our efforts going forward on those routes where operators and Transit drivers identified issues."

"As everyone knows, we had a great deal of snow to move this time around, and a number of consecutive snowfalls to handle," said Bob Dunford, Director of Roadway Maintenance (Transportation Services). "I want to thank the crews for working so hard around the clock over the last seven days, and express my gratitude to all of those who complied with the parking ban and made our jobs that much easier."



The parking ban ended at noon on Sunday, November 24. Crews will now move into neighbourhoods to start blading to level snow pack at 12:01 am on Tuesday, November 26.

While there is no parking ban in place for blading in residential areas, the City asks citizens to move their vehicles or park off-street wherever possible so that trucks can blade from curb to curb. Blading is a 24-hour, around the clock operation; crews can be in neighbourhoods at any time on the date indicated on the schedule. Please note that depending on the amount of snow in some areas and delays caused by vehicles parked on the streets, the schedule is subject to change.
