An eight-year-old boy from Mchael A Kostek School will be promoted to Edmonton Fire Rescue Services' Junior Fire Chief for a Day.

Taran Sandhu-Hothi beat out thousands of other elementary school applicants for the job in a contest held by Fire Prevention Officers during Fire Prevention Week.

The Junior Chief will be picked up from school in a fire rescue truck and tour fire stations and City Hall. He will be formally promoted at a special lunchtime ceremony at Fire Station 1 presided over by Chief Ken Block.

This annual event is held to raise awareness about fire prevention and reward students for demonstrating a commitment to fire safety.
