



CF-18s Will Be Last Planes to Fly Out of City Centre Airport

The City of Edmonton wishes to inform citizens that tomorrow afternoon there will be flypasts from two CF-18 jets (weather permitting). The flypasts will cause a higher than usual noise disturbance that is expected to end by approximately 5 p.m.

ACF-18 will perform a touch-and-go, making it the last aircraft to leave the airport, and two jets will perform the flypast as part of the event to mark the official closure of the City Centre Airport. The CF-18 jets acknowledge the airfield's history as two Royal Canadian Air Force Siskins were the first aircraft to land when Blatchford Field officially opened in 1927.
