



## Angle parking not allowed on city streets unless indicated

The City of Edmonton reminds residents not to angle park on city streets unless a sign indicates angle parking is permitted. Vehicles that are angle parked make it difficult for emergency vehicles to access streets that are snow-covered.

Angle parking is especially problematic on cul de sacs. Anyone found to be angle parked in a cul de sac or other non-designated areas will be subject to a fine.

The City's [Waste Management Services](#) vehicles are also having a difficult time maneuvering around cul de sacs due to people angle parking. Residents with front street waste pick-up are asked to park vehicles off the street on their collection day.

Other motorists may have trouble with line of sight, getting through, or simply trying to get out of their driveways because vehicles are in the way.
