

Hawrelak Park Ice Rink Opens

Lace up your skates and head to William Hawrelak Park! An ice rink will open in the park on **Friday, December 13, 2013**. Necessary repairs to the lake in Hawrelak Park have meant a move to a temporary ice surface for this winter season.

Hours: 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily

Admission: Free



The rink covers approximately 8,000 square metres, making it slightly larger than the playing surface at Commonwealth Stadium. It will be lit for evening skating.

A temporary trailer where people can change into skates and warm up will be available. Portable toilets have also been set up.
