

City Improves Online Blading Schedule

It's now going to be easier for Edmontonians to find out when their neighbourhood will be bladed. The City of Edmonton has improved its online search tool dedicated to neighbourhood snow blading.

Neighbourhood blading takes place after arterial and collector roadways have been plowed. Residents can now enter their address into a new search tool to see when blading is scheduled, in progress or completed on their streets.



The City's website previously listed neighbourhood blading status by neighbourhood.

When a neighbourhood blading cycle begins, announcements will continue to be made through traditional and social media, email subscription and City website postings. Digital messaging boards around the city will also indicate when blading is in progress. Citizens are advised to use these resources or call 311 to learn when crews will be on their streets. Blading schedules are updated twice daily.

PLEASE NOTE: Schedules may change depending on the accumulation of snow and the number of parked vehicles on neighbourhood streets.

Citizens are asked to remove their vehicles from neighbourhood streets when blading is scheduled so that streets can be bladed to a snowpack of 5 centimetres or less from curb to curb. Blading is a 24 hour operation and may begin anytime on the scheduled date.

Citizens are thanked in advance for their cooperation. Any concerns about neighbourhood blading status, schedules or the new online search tool should be reported to 311 for prompt attention.
