



Seasonal Parking Ban Ends

Compliance levels low in many areas

The City of Edmonton will lift the seasonal parking ban today, Monday, December 16, 2013 at 3 p.m.

"I want to thank the crews for working around the clock, especially when we had to pull an entire shift off of plowing and respond to the freezing rain on Saturday, December 14, 2013. And although we'd certainly appreciate greater compliance, I do want to thank those who did move their vehicles off-street to help make our jobs easier," said Bob Dunford, Director of Roadway Maintenance.

Parking by-law enforcement officers had issued 1080 tickets by the end of the day on Sunday, December 15, 2013. Because crews are still working on the roads, enforcement on parking ban routes will continue until 3 p.m. on Monday, December 16, 2013.

The City anticipates starting a neighbourhood blading cycle mid-week. An announcement about blading will be made once the date and time have been determined.
