

Neighbourhood Blading to Begin

City of Edmonton Roadway Maintenance crews will move into neighbourhoods to start blading to a level 5 cm snow pack at 12:01 a.m. on Wednesday, December 18, 2013.

While there is not a parking ban in place for blading in residential areas, the City asks citizens to move their vehicles or park off-street wherever possible so that trucks can blade from curb to curb. Residents are reminded that while windrows are kept to a maximum 30 cm height in front of driveways, curbside windrows are not removed. Those wishing to continue parking on-street after the work has been done are required to clear a spot for themselves.



Blading is a 24-hour, around the clock operation; crews can be in neighbourhoods at any time on the date indicated on the schedule (from midnight to midnight). To use the new online blading schedule, visit edmonton.ca/snowremoval.

Residents can now enter their address online to see when blading is scheduled, in progress or completed on their streets.

Please note that depending on the amount of snow in some areas and delays caused by vehicles parked on the streets, the schedule is subject to change.
