



## Edmonton to Outperform National Economy: 2013 Review and Outlook for 2014

City of Edmonton Chief Economist John Rose will be available for year-end interviews to review Edmonton's economic performance in 2013 and the economic outlook for 2014.

Some of the economic highlights include the following:

- Year-to-date values in employment suggest that employment growth should come in the 3% range in 2013 — significantly higher than the national average.
- Inflation in the Edmonton region has been unusually low.
- Edmonton's healthy economic performance gives significant internal momentum to the local economy, which will help to insulate the city and the region from external shocks.

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
