Citizens are invited to learn more about the City's planned streetscape improvements to the 105 Avenue corridor between 109 Street and 119 Street on the northwest edge of downtown.

Date: Tuesday, January 21, 2014

Location: Paul Byrne Hall, Robbins Health Learning Centre
MacEwan University, 10910-104 Avenue



This project will transform 105 Avenue from a collector roadway into a local roadway used primarily by residents and businesses in the area. Design plans include dedicated bike lanes, shared-use pathways, landscaped sidewalks and curb extensions and limited on-street parking.

A road closure at 113 Street will create additional green space. Streetscape improvements and infill redevelopment will help shape the physical, economic and cultural character of the area.

Display materials and project team members will be available for discussion. There will be a presentation at 6 p.m.
