Have your say in finding the way in Gold Bar Park

A new and unified look has been developed for signs in Edmonton's river valley, and the City is testing the new signs in Gold Bar Park. We'd like the public's feedback on the signs, and where they should be placed.

Groups representing Edmontonians who use river valley parks and trails throughout the year have provided input on the design of the new signs.



The City is looking to hear from those who use Gold Bar Park on a regular basis. Where should the signs be placed in the park? Are the signs easy to understand and follow?

Location: Gold Bar Park pavilion

The City will use the feedback from this public input session to refine the information on the signs for Gold Bar and where to place them when it comes time to install signage in late summer or early fall of 2014. The signs will eventually be placed throughout the river valley.
