Public information session: Clareview Fire Station 18 revitalization

Edmontonians are invited to attend an open house and public information session to learn about the upcoming revitalization and temporary redeployment of services from Clareview Fire Station 18 to two nearby stations: Beverly (Station 7) and Belle Rive (Station 25).

In order to continue to provide excellent fire response services to Edmontonians, Edmonton Fire Rescue Services' Master Plan includes measures to extend the life of its existing fire stations.

The Clareview Station, built in 1978, is one of the oldest fire stations in Edmonton. Much of the building's 36-year-old infrastructure is reaching the end of its life cycle and needs to be renovated.

Edmonton Fire Rescue Services Deputy Chief of Operations Barry Lamb and Deputy Chief of Training and Logistics Keven Lefebvre will present information on this revitalization and temporary redeployment at 2:30, 3:30 and 4:30 p.m.

Fire Prevention, Training and Recruitment, and the Office of Emergency Management will also have displays and representatives at the event to discuss their services.
