Are you interested in an exciting and fast-paced career that will challenge you both physically and mentally? You can help improve the livability of Edmonton by protecting life, property and the environment as a member of the Edmonton Fire Rescue Services team, an internationally-recognized provider of emergency response services.



From **March 1 to 31, 2014**, Edmonton Fire Rescue Services will be accepting applications for its firefighter recruit training class of 2015. New recruits are accepted once a year.

Candidates are chosen based on their aptitude, personal suitability and their ability to meet physical fitness requirements. The application and screening process can take up to one year, with successful candidates on the eligibility list being notified as new classes begin.

Training lasts 12 weeks. Recruits graduate as probationary firefighters and are then trained to respond to a variety of emergency response situations. They develop skills in core areas including fire suppression, medical event response, vehicle extraction, technical rescues, and hazardous materials.

Edmonton Fire Rescue Services is committed to an inclusive hiring process to attract and retain outstanding employees.
