City staff will share potential design options and possible locations of traffic calming measures identified through online public survey and stakeholder meetings. Citizens will have the opportunity to provide feedback on design options that could reduce traffic volumes and decrease speeding through the neighbourhood.

Project team members will be available to answer questions, note any concerns and gather comments.
