Prince Charles Community Traffic Management Plan Workshop

Edmontonians are invited to attend a drop-in workshop to learn more about potential traffic management measures in Prince Charles. The City is hosting the workshop on two dates and citizens are invited to attend either one.

Date: Wednesday, March 12, 2014 or

Tuesday, March 18, 2014

Time: 4 – 8 p.m.

Location: Prince Charles School, 12325-127 Street



City staff will share potential design options and possible locations as identified through January's online public survey and stakeholder meetings. Citizens will learn more about the advantages and disadvantages of various types of traffic calming measures and can provide feedback on possible modifications that could reduce traffic volumes and decrease speeding through the neighbourhood.

Project team members will be available to answer questions, note any concerns and gather comments. Some design options could significantly impact traffic patterns in and around the area.

The City of Edmonton is working with the Prince Charles community on this community traffic planning study.
