Lane Closure: 104 Avenue, 102 Street to 104 Street

The north curb lane on 104 Avenue, between 102 Street and 104 Street, will be closed as of March 13, 2014, and will be closed for the duration of the construction of Rogers Place.

The travel lanes are being shifted to maintain two lanes of westbound traffic, and three lanes of eastbound traffic.

Traffic impacts include:

- No left turn from 104 Avenue westbound onto 103 Street southbound
- No left turn from 104 Avenue eastbound onto 103 Street northbound
- No left turn from 104 Avenue westbound to 104 Street southbound

The left turn from 104 Avenue eastbound to 104 Street northbound will be maintained to allow access to the Square 104 apartment building.

The entire project will take about two and a half years to complete. Rogers Place is scheduled to be completed September 2016. It is an important catalyst in the revitalization of Edmonton's downtown.
