The City will share the preliminary neighbourhood reconstruction plans, including pedestrian and cycling accessibility and improvements. Residents and property owners will have the chance to learn more about construction timelines and the local improvement process, as well as share local knowledge and make suggestions to improve neighbourhood livability.

Neighbourhood reconstruction is part of the City's Building Great Neighbourhoods initiative. This initiative coordinates three City programs—Drainage Neighbourhood Renewal, Neighbourhood Renewal and the Great Neighbourhoods Capital Program—to improve livability through the renewal and enhancement of neighbourhood infrastructure.
