## Windermere condo fire deliberately set

Edmonton Fire Rescue Services has completed its investigation into the cause of a March 15, 2014, fire at a Windermere condo development at 10 Avenue and 173 Street. Examination of the scene has revealed that the fire was deliberately set.



The fire resulted in \$6 million in damages to the condo development, which was under construction at the time of the blaze.

The investigation is now with Edmonton Police Service and further inquiries can be directed to their office.
