It's tee time as Victoria Driving Range, Rundle Course open

Golfers are taking their first swings of the season today at the Victoria Driving Range. The 61 stall, two-tiered range will be open daily from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., with hours extended as conditions permit.

After getting in some practice swings at Victoria, golfers can take to the greens starting April 11 at Rundle Park golf course. The course will open on permanent greens. Due to early season conditions, only pull-carts and walking are allowed. Opening tee times will depend on frost.

This season, Rundle Park will open the Rundle Park Grill and 19th Hole, with an expanded menu including traditional favourites and more healthy options.

The Rundle Park Golf Course pro shop is also open, with 2014 Golf Multi-Passes and Golf Discount Cards available for golfers who want to get the most out of the 2014 season. Pro shops at Riverside Golf Course and Victoria Golf Course opened in early April.

Operations staff is monitoring Victoria Golf Course and Riverside Golf Course and they will open as soon as course conditions permit.
