Edmonton's Online Census Popular

In the first three days of the City of Edmonton's first online census, 41,851 households completed their census questionnaire online. This is approximately 11 per cent of Edmonton residences.

A secure access code is required to complete the census online. The City of Edmonton has mailed a secure access code and directions on how to complete the census to all Edmonton households.



The online part of the Edmonton 2014 Census began April 10 at 8 a.m. and will end April 27 at 8 p.m.

Answering the questions takes only a few minutes and can be done from any computer connected to the Internet. The information collected is confidential and stored in a secure database located in Canada. The online census web pages are secure and are not affected by the Heartbleed bug.

Census information is important for planning and delivering City services. It also ensures that the City of Edmonton receives appropriate funding from other orders of government.

On May 10, 2014, Census workers start door to door collection of census data from Edmontonians who did not take part in the online census.
