## City seeks input into Bonnie Doon Campus Park

The City of Edmonton has identified Bonnie Doon Campus Park (recently renamed Dermott District Park) as a park for potential future improvement, through the District Park Renewal Program.

Part of the decision process includes gathering feedback from the park's users, residents and community organizations. A drop-in session has been set up for all interested stakeholders to hear more about the proposed plans, and to provide feedback on conceptual plans that have been developed.
