Trail closures and work begins for 102 Avenue Bridge project

Early work continues in preparation for the closure of the 102 Avenue over Groat Road Bridge this summer.

Starting **April 29, 2014**, there will be a full closure in place for four months on the Groat Road shared-use path from 107 Avenue to the MacKinnon Ravine. Pedestrian and cyclist detours information is available on the project website.

Also, for two weeks beginning **April 28, 2014**, construction crews will be doing shoring work on the Wellington Bridge, located west of the Royal Alberta Museum. This temporary shoring work is necessary to allow the bridge to support heavy truck traffic going to the 102 Avenue over Groat Road Bridge construction site. The shoring will go into the ravine underneath, but will not affect access for trail users.

The 102 Avenue over Groat Road Bridge will close on July 1. It will be demolished and replaced with a new bridge. Construction is expected to last 15 months.
