City seeks input to guide river access

A 10-year River Access Strategy is being developed to define locations and regulations around building waterside infrastructure and amenities to enhance citizens' enjoyment of the North Saskatchewan River

Edmonton residents are invited to provide input by completing an online survey. The survey will be online until May 31, 2014.



Input gathered will be used to guide the development of the 10-year strategy, which will provide guidelines for current and future infrastructure in the North Saskatchewan River Valley. This would include boat docks and launches as well as supporting amenities such as access roads, parking lots, washrooms and storage facilities provided by the City and its partners.

The River Access Strategy will balance environmental stewardship with responsible development to encourage a broader appreciation for activities on the river and in the river valley.
