The mural, painted by local artist Kris Friesen, is a vivid depiction of the Town of Beverly from its 19th century coal mining roots through the agricultural era of the 1930s and 40s.

<u>Capital City Clean Up's</u> Graffiti Management Program in conjunction with 630 CHED radio developed the <u>Giants of Edmonton Mural Program</u> as a way to beautify the city, honour Edmonton's best, and deter graffiti vandalism.
