Gardens grow from the Muttart Conservatory plant sale

Beautiful plants and expert advice are on offer at the Muttart Conservatory's annual Bedding Plant Sale.

Dates and Times:

Admission: free admission to the Bedding Plant Sale

This year's sale will feature water garden planters, a broad selection of "basket-stuffers" for creative gardeners, and tomatoes in many sizes. Vertical succulent gardens and large "seashell" planters are distinctive choices for people who want their yards to stand out.

Plant-lovers without room to garden can bring home small potted herbs and herb gardens, cactus dish gardens, or balcony hanging baskets designed for sun and shade. Growers will be at the sale to answer questions and provide advice on plant care.

Visitors should follow signs and take the road to the greenhouse entrance, near the Muttart Conservatory. Parking is limited.
