Proposed rezoning in McCauley neighbourhood

Citizens are invited to a public meeting to discuss a proposal to rezone properties located on the northwest corner of 97 Street and 105 Avenue NW within the McCauley neighbourhood.

Date: Tuesday, May 27, 2014

Time: 7 p.m

Location: St. Josaphat Cathedral Parish Hall, 9637-108 Avenue

The proposed project would allow the opportunity for a mixed use, high rise development with the following: two towers; 130 metre maximum Height; 296 dwelling units; and commercial development within a five storey podium

To facilitate the proposed rezoning, this application includes an amendment to the Boyle Street/McCauley Area Redevelopment Plan and a closure of a portion of road right-of-way (rear lane).

The purpose of the meeting is to allow for citizens to learn about the proposal and provide feedback to the City and property owner. Feedback will be summarized in a report to City Council before council makes its decision on the rezoning.
