City reaches agreement with Fire Fighters Union on new contract

The City has reached an agreement with the Edmonton Fire Fighters Union on a new six-year contract that covers 2011 to the end of 2016.

The contract calls for general wages increases of:

- 2011 of 3.6%
- 2012 of 2% in Jan and 2% in July (4%)
- 2013 of 3%
- 2014 of 2%
- 2015 of 2.25%
- 2016 of 2.5%

"We're pleased to reach an agreement with the Edmonton Fire Fighters Union," said Pamela Kirkwood, the City's Director of Labour Relations.

The Edmonton Fire Fighter's Union (IAFF Local 209) is an affiliate of the International Association of Fire Fighters and represents over 1,000 members consisting of uniformed dispatchers, firefighters, inspectors, investigators, mechanics, and support personnel that serve the citizens of the [City of Edmonton](http://www.edmonton.ca).

The Fire Association ratified the agreement late Friday, May 16, 2014.
