Queen Elizabeth Outdoor Pool is scheduled to open on Wednesday, June 4, with Oliver Outdoor Pool scheduled to open on Saturday, June 14, weather permitting. Borden Park Outdoor Pool is closed for redevelopment with an anticipated reopening date of 2016.

Our temperature-controlled outdoor pools are safe and fun for the whole family, whether it's public swim, lane swim, lessons or summer camps. Operating hours are subject to change and pools may close due to inclement weather.

Monthly passes are available from \$31 per month for unlimited use of an outdoor pool. People can also use their City of Edmonton recreation facility memberships at outdoor pools.
