The Oil Kings won the Ed Chynoweth Cup (WHL) on May 12, defeating the Portland Winterhawks. They went on to beat the Guelph Storm by a score of 6-3 on May 25 to win the prestigious <u>MasterCard Memorial Cup</u> (CHL). It was the first championship win for the Oil Kings since 1966. The Memorial Cup has been given to Canada's junior hockey champions since 1919 in memory of those who died in World War I.
