Strathcona Bike Route

Downtown Bike Route

Date: June 18, 2014 or June 19, 2014

Time: 6 – 9:30 p.m.

Location: Boyle Street Community League, 9538-103A Avenue

Each evening will begin with some fun bike-themed activities followed by the formal workshop program at 6:30 p.m. Project staff will present several route location options and discuss advantages and challenges for each. This is an opportunity for the public to learn more about the project and to help choose the location for each bike route.

Supervised child-friendly activities will be available throughout the evening.

It is part of *What the B*ke*, an awareness and education campaign that invites Edmontonians to share thoughts about cycling in Edmonton.
