MacEwan University plans property rezoning

Edmontonians are invited to review and provide feedback on a proposed rezoning and amendment to the Central McDougall/Queen Mary Park Area Development Plan (ARP). The rezoning is from a Direct Development Control Provision (DC1) to the Urban Institutional Zone (UI).

Date: Thursday, June 19, 2014

Time: 7 p.m.

Location: MacEwan City Centre Campus,
109th Street Building – Robbins Health Learning Centre
Main Floor Atrium - Cafeteria, 10700-104 Avenue NW

The rezoning would allow the continuation of existing commercial uses and the development of temporary surface parking for land between 108 Street NW and 112 Street NW, south of 105 Avenue NW. The application also incorporates general urban design principles of the ARP and would allow university development over the longer term.

An amendment to the Central McDougall/Queen Mary Park Area Redevelopment Plan and an amendment to the portion of the UI Zone that deals with the MacEwan University– Downtown Campus would also be part of the application.

This public meeting provides residents with an opportunity to learn more about the proposal and give feedback to the City and the applicant. Comments will be summarized in a report to City Council before Council makes a decision on the application.
