Open house for proposed Horse Hill neighbourhood plan

Edmontonians are invited to an open house for the proposed Horse Hill Neighbourhood Structure Plan (NSP) within the Horse Hill Area Structure Plan (ASP).

Date: Thursday, June 26, 2014 Time: 6 - 8 p.m. Location: Horse Hill Elementary School, 19355 Meridian Street NE

The proposed NSP encompasses about 600 hectares of primarily residential uses, a district park site, recreation centre, natural areas and storm ponds, a fire hall, town centre with a main street and a proposed LRT Station and Transit Centre.

The file planner will give a brief presentation at 6 p.m. on the plan and process.

This open house provides residents an opportunity to learn more about the proposal and give feedback to the City and the applicant. Comments will be summarized in a report to City Council before Council makes a decision on the application.
