Flying Eagle Program staff have created a book to educate kids about Aboriginal culture in honour of the anniversary. The book is free to all kids who attend the anniversary celebration and is available at any Green Shack operating the Flying Eagle Program. The book is available in English and Cree, and is also available online.

The event will begin with a prayer from an Elder, and City staff will speak about the program's history and how it has educated a new generation of children about Aboriginal history and culture.
