Paint the portrait of post-secondary

Calling all artists! Get your palettes ready and your paint brushes primed. Capital City Cleanup is looking for an artist to paint the next [Giants of Edmonton mural](#) celebrating post-secondary education in the city.

The competition is open to all artists currently residing in Alberta. Artists should submit their mural ideas by 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, August 6, 2014 using the proposal submission guidelines outlined at edmonton.ca/capitalcitycleanup.

The winning artist will be chosen by a panel of judges consisting of representatives from Capital City Clean Up, the property owner, Corus Radio (630 CHED) and the local community. The mural will be posted on the east-facing wall of the Panama Enterprises building located at 12010 121A Street.



Capital City Clean Up's Graffiti Management Program, in conjunction with 630 CHED radio, developed the Giants of Edmonton Mural Program as a way to beautify the city, honour Edmonton's best, and deter graffiti vandalism. Mural subjects are nominated through an online poll of 630 CHED listeners. The City of Edmonton then selects the subject from among the suggestions and finances the mural.
