Getting to the FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup Canada 2014

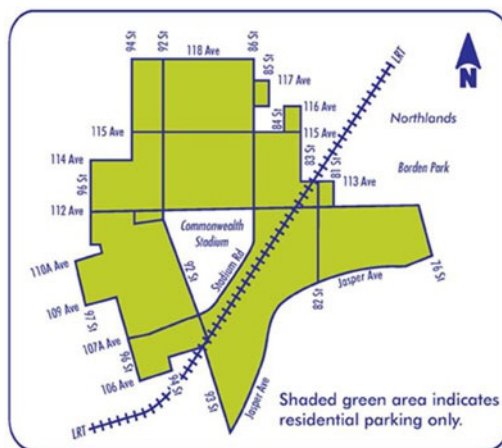
Join Edmonton and Canada as we prepare to welcome the world to this international event. As an official host city, Edmonton will host seven matches during the competition at Commonwealth Stadium, including group matches on August 5, 8, and 13, with the quarterfinal match on August 16. Here are some things you need to know to make the most of your FIFA experience.



Residential Parking Ban

The FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup Canada 2014 matches are declared a major event, therefore, a residential parking ban goes into effect. Parking is restricted on all signed streets from the start of the first match until one hour after the end of the event. Any vehicle not displaying a valid residential parking permit will be tagged and towed at the owner's expense.

Please Note: Parking is restricted around Commonwealth Stadium and the LRT Station. Signs are posted at these locations.



LRT & Bus Service to the Matches

LRT service is increased for match nights. Catch the LRT at Century Park, Southgate, South Campus/Fort Edmonton Park, McKernan/Belgravia, Health Sciences/Jubilee, University, Grandin, Corona, Bay/Enterprise Square, Central, Churchill, Coliseum, Belvedere, or Clareview stations.

[Route 2](#) - West Edmonton Mall - Downtown - Stadium - Highlands

Travel from West Edmonton Mall Transit Centre, Jasper Avenue or Highlands to Stadium LRT Station. Weekend and evening service every 30 minutes.

Park & Ride Information

We'll get you to the match with our non-stop direct service with a single Park & Ride lot from Kingsway Garden Mall (109 Street and Kingsway Avenue). Service starts 90 minutes before the first match.

ETS Fares

For fans who have purchased their game day ticket in advance, it is valid on LRT or regular ETS bus service for two hours before games, during the games, and two hours after the games end.

It's also your ticket to ride on ETS Park & Ride service.

Enjoy the games, and remember to keep your ticket stub for your return trip.

If you're buying your ticket at the gate, regular ETS fares apply for travel to the game. Keep your ticket stub for a free ride home after the game. ETS tickets, monthly passes and transfers are also valid on ETS Park & Ride service.
