100 years of history at Beechmount Cemetery open house

A representative from Edmonton's City Archives will conduct a tour, showing how local history can be read in the monuments. Beechmount Cemetery has represented the character of Edmonton since it opened as the city's first Municipal Cemetery, quickly becoming an important multicultural space and a special resting place for veterans. At the open house, Cemeteries staff members will be in attendance to answer questions and discuss the future of Beechmount and other Municipal Cemeteries.

Refreshments will be available. Guests are encouraged to bring insect repellent, and umbrellas in case of rain.
