Got a great idea? Want to share it? Edmonton's NextGen is looking for presenters for Pecha Kucha Night 20 (PKN 20), scheduled for October 2, 2014, at the Royal Alberta Museum.

From the Japanese phrase for "the sound of chit chat," Pecha Kucha Nights are fun, informal gatherings where some of our city's most engaged current and future leaders present inspirational ideas that have the power to transform our city.



PKN speakers present their ideas with the help of 20 images shown for 20 seconds each, for a maximum presentation time of six minutes and 40 seconds. This format keeps presentations fast-paced, concise and entertaining.

More than 200 presentations have been given so far at Edmonton's Pecha Kucha Nights, reaching audiences of engaged and creative young people on wide-ranging topics – from urban beekeeping to electric-powered cars and everything in between. NextGen, a group of young, community-minded individuals supporting initiatives of interest to the "Next Generation," was the first to host Pecha Kucha Nights in Western Canada.
