Avoid getting a ticket and park responsibly

The City of Edmonton is reminding students and parents as they head back to school to park responsibly, obey all parking signs and avoid jaywalking. Parking enforcement officers will be out looking for cars parked illegally around post-secondary institutions and grade schools. Officers will also be ticketing jaywalkers.

A zero-tolerance enforcement campaign begins Thursday, September 4, 2014 and will run until Monday, October 6, 2014. Illegally-parked cars will be ticketed and towed without warning. Owners could face fines starting at \$50, plus any towing and impound fees.

Parking illegally around grade schools creates site obstructions and other safety issues for children. In order to maintain safety, parents are encouraged to park further away and walk small children to the door rather than trying to park in front of the school to drop them off.
