Edmonton Transit's DATS (Disabled Adult Transit Service) is opening the big garage doors at Wickman to welcome customers, friends and neighbours to learn more about DATS.

DATS invites Edmontonians to come meet the staff, take a behind the scenes tour, check out technology demonstrations, and learn more about accessible ETS and explore the many vehicles used to provide DATS service.



DATS is a door-to-door, specialized public transportation service for adults who cannot use regular transit for some or all trips because of a physical and/or cognitive disability. DATS is not a taxi service – it is a shared-ride, accommodated transportation service operating within the City of Edmonton.

Trips are scheduled to make maximum use of this shared-ride service. DATS is scheduled and operated by the DATS Section of Edmonton Transit System (ETS). The DATS budget is primarily supported by the City of Edmonton tax levy and the cost of the service is partially offset with the fares collected from DATS customers.
