## Edmonton Fire Rescue to honour fallen members

On September 11, the Edmonton Firefighters Memorial Society will hold its Annual Remembrance Service for active and retired members who have passed away in the previous year, as well as all the Edmonton firefighters who have died in the line of duty.

The event will also mark the thirteenth anniversary of the terrorist attacks on the World Trade Centre in New York, the single greatest loss of firefighters in history.

Uniformed members will march from the Connaught Armory at 10 a.m. and muster in front of the Firefighters Memorial Plaza. The service will include a speaking program with comments from Fire Chief Ken Block, Edmonton Firefighter Union President Greg Holubowich, Councillor Ben Henderson, MLA Blake Pederson, MLA Rachel Notley, MLADr. Raj Sherman, MLA Matt Jeneroux, and City Chaplain John Dowds. Awreath laying ceremony will follow, and the program will conclude with a "last alarm" bell service, to honour the fallen firefighters.
