Firefighters training for river valley embankment rescues

Edmonton Fire Rescue Services Technical Rescue Team will be at Rio Park on Thursday afternoon conducting River Valley embankment rescue training exercises. The training will involve eight firefighters lowering each other down the embankment on a twin tension rope system, placing a patient on a stretcher, and lifting the patient and rescuers safely back to the top of the

Each rescue will take about 10 minutes. Technical Rescue Coordinator Corey Selby will be available at the base of the embankment for interviews.
