

Survey looks for feedback on River Valley/Groat Road interchange

The City of Edmonton would like to hear about your experience travelling through the interchange which connects River Valley Road, Groat Road and Victoria Park Road.

Almost 12,000 vehicles move through the interchange during rush hour. It is a popular route for motorists, cyclists and pedestrians traveling to Downtown, the University of Alberta and City parks, but its winding roads and quick turn-offs can make it difficult to navigate.



An [online survey](#) aims to gather input from citizens about traffic delays, signage or conflict points between drivers, cyclists and pedestrians.

The survey will run until October 17, 2014.

The information gathered from the survey will inform the development of design options for the area. These draft concept plans will be presented to the public at an Open House in November.
